

Potts Company Announces Dedication of Safety Complex and CM-At Risk for DeKalb County.

The Potts Company announced the dedication of the Forsyth County Public Safety Complex. The dedication ceremony included remarks from Forsyth County officials, raising of the flags, the official ribbon cutting and the presentation of the September 11, 2001 Memorial. The Memorial, placed in the lobby of the Public Safety Complex, is a section of a steel beam from the World Trade Center given to the county by the New York Fire Department.

The two-building complex is comprised of a Public Safety Building and a new four bay Fire Station. The Public Safety Building houses the Fire Department Headquarters, 911 Dispatch Center, Emergency Operations Center, Sheriff's office training space, a 200-seat multi-purpose auditorium, administrative offices and Fire Arms Training Simulation (FATS). The dispatch system for the 911 Center is an 800 Megahertz digital spectrum simulcast system.

The Potts Company has been selected to provide Construction Management At-Risk (CM At-Risk) services to the DeKalb County Public Safety and Judicial Facilities Authority for the interior renovation of the DeKalb County Courthouse located in downtown Decatur, Georgia. The project requires the complete interior demolition down to the elevator core and renovation of the nine story structure

originally built in 1967. Potts was selected based on qualifications, price and the detailed logistics plan that will assure the security and continued operations of all county government functions housed in the building.
